











Rent Increase April 2021 - Help us to make the right decision YOUR VIEWS WILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE

We want to hear from you by Friday 27 November 2020

Each year we look at how much rent is needed to continue to provide great services and improve our properties. We want to keep your rent affordable so it is important that we hear your views so we get the balance between rent levels and services right.

2020 will always be remembered for Covid-19 and the change it brought to all our lives. We know this has been a difficult year for many of our tenants. Some people have lost their job and many are struggling financially. So we want to make the rent increase in April as low as possible.

Our starting point is to look at the September rate of inflation as this is used when changes are made to benefits and pensions. In September 2020 inflation was 0.7%. We have worked out that this is the lowest amount of rent increase needed so we can continue with the same services as last year and carry out the improvements we have planned to our properties over the next 5 years.

The Board will make a decision on the rent increase in January 2021 after they have considered all the feedback from tenants on this issue.

Our Investment Plans

We plan to spend £38m over the next 5 years to improve our properties and the surrounding environment. The 5 Year Investment Programme 2019-2024 details the year that work will be carried out in each area. 
The table below shows examples of an average weekly rent for different property types and sizes. This gives you a rough guide as to the likely rent increase for your home. Rents do vary slightly between property type, size and age.

2 bedroom Flat (multi)	£350.32	£352.77	£2.45

2 bedroom House	£418.50	£421.43	£2.93
3 bedroom House	£447.79	£450.92	£3.13
4 bedroom House	£469.02	£472.30	£3.28

How we spent the rent collected in 2019/20

We collected around £20.15m in rent and services charges and we spent £18.3m on the following service areas:.

was spent managing homes and estate services



£5.7m

was spent on cyclical and reactive repairs



£1.9m

was spent on housing support



£1.2m

was spent on refurbishing existing homes



£0.7m

was spent on community activities

It has many other features that help you manage your Queens Cross tenancy.


